

AN INDUSTRY OF RACISM

The following are excerpts from a guest commentary in the *Denver Post, August 21, 2008*. This commentary was written by Dr. Alveda King, niece of Martin Luther King, Jr. following the opening of a new “50,000-square-foot, big-box-abortion store,” built by Planned Parenthood (PP) in Stapleton.

“Gated and nicely landscaped, the facility is the latest façade erected by an industry that has operated behind veneers, euphemisms, and outright falsehoods for its entire existence.

“What’s not new is the fact that the killing tools of abortionists are as aimed at blacks today as the fire hoses of segregationists 50 years ago, taking more African-American lives than gun violence, heart disease, cancer and AIDS combined.

“Abortion seems to have targeted blacks in a way that can only make remaining Ku Klux Klan members smile. The numbers speak for themselves.

“According to the abortion industry’s own Alan Guttmacher Institute, black women are 4.8 times more likely to have an abortion than white women. African-Americans comprise about 13 percent of the population; yet receive 37 percent of all abortions.

“The racism in PP’s history is undeniable... founded by Margaret Sanger, a woman who wanted what she termed “more children from the fit, less from the unfit.” She once described aboriginal Australians as “just a step higher than the chimpanzee in brain development.” She had no problem speaking to a Klan meeting.

“That racism still exists in PP is also undeniable. The unborn are obviously easier to discriminate against than any group of born humans. They cannot march. They cannot protest. They are invisible – until they appear on a sonogram or their remains are reassembled on an abortionist’s table.

“Even in death, they are anonymously incinerated or sometimes just bagged and tossed in a dumpster. It would almost seem like the aborted unborn never existed – if we didn’t go to such great lengths to end their existence.

“Since Colorado became the first state to liberalize its abortion law in 1967, over 50 million Americans have gone missing. They are now gone because too many of us believed the lies that unborn babies aren’t really babies and human lives don’t begin at their beginnings. I know. Two of those 50 million were my own children. You and I, who lived for years in the comfort of denial, can no longer do so... Fifty million missing won’t let us.”

In Atlanta, Georgia on November 11, 2008 – Dr. Alveda King said that, while the election of an African –American president is a milestone for America; abortion continues and her uncle, Martin Luther King’s dreams of equal rights, **for all**, has yet to be fulfilled.

“President-elect Obama has promised actions that will only increase the number of abortions. As pro-lifers, we must promise to redouble our efforts to resist anti-life proposals, speak up for the babies, and above all, pray.

“We must pray with persistence and love that, in God’s time, what is now deemed unthinkable will become reality – that all our brothers and sisters, from conception to natural death, will be protected in law and welcomed in society. **The elections are over. The pro-life battle begins anew**”.

SUBWAY RIDERS RESPOND TO POST ABORTION AD

A unique advertising campaign in New York City subways that reaches out to men and women suffering from abortions, or experiencing the pain of an abortion through a loved one, is yielding results.

The campaign relies on the tag line "abortion changes you," and has been seen by hundreds of thousands of subway riders during one month last fall.

More than 1,400 New Yorkers have responded by visiting the 'Abortion Changes You' website.

Michaelene Fredenburg, author, and creator of the ads, shared some of the responses.

A woman wrote, "I would like to thank you for listening to my story. I thought and felt like I was the only one who was going through this."

Another woman carried her secret for two years and didn't seek help. She experienced depression and difficulty in school until she told friends about her abortion.

A family member shared the loss of two siblings because of abortion. "It hurt me deeply to know that I had a brother and/or sister who was taken from me... my mother spent many years grieving and healing."

Fredenburg said that, "reaching out after her own abortion was a turning point for her. She knew she was not alone and was able to talk about her experience."

The top feelings submitted this last month were "alone," "ashamed", and "changed."

## **Points Made Against Sex Education - Part 3**

8. The reliance on condoms has been dangerously misleading. There are sexually transmitted diseases (e.g. Human Papilloma Virus, HPV) for which condoms offer no protection.

Condom use has failed particularly in Africa. They create the false impression of safety, thus encouraging sex, when there is a 13% (at least) chance of dying as a result.

9. There is nothing in sex education that cannot be part of a more effective general health education. Everything of value in sex education can be integrated with the necessary knowledge of how the body and mind work.

We found that by using the young person's curiosity and letting them discover how their heart, lungs, etc. work, gives them a natural desire to protect something very precious – their mind and body.

10. There is an enormous sex industry that financially profits from natural biological drives and makes billions on fashions, condoms, contraceptives, etc. It is understandable they contribute to the sex problems. (To be continued)

## International “Family Planning”

In a recent article published in *International Family Planning Perspectives*, the authors press for legalization of abortion in pro-life nations.

Among other activities, the distribution of “abortion drugs” (i.e. RU 486) is recommended to promote legalizing abortion.

In their report of the article, C-Fam Friday Fax includes the reaction of Dr. Donna Harrison, the President of the American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists.

According to Harrison **“making abortion legal does not make it safe.”**

Harrison explained that RU 486 has a **“ten times increased risk of death from infection”** compared to surgical abortions.

Harrison also warns that: “To make medical abortion available to women who do not have immediate access to surgical facilities and transfusions is tantamount to **female genocide.**”

## **“Prevention First” – Millions to the Abortion Industry**

Senate bill S. 21, **Prevention First**, was filed at the beginning of the 2009 session of Congress.

The bill is aimed – supposedly – at prevention of venereal diseases among adolescents and people through age 24, by way of the morning-after pill (Plan B) – which hospitals would have to make available to rape victims without parental involvement or full information of the workings of Plan B – and sex education.

“Comprehensive sexuality programs...” Abstinence-only programs would be de-funded and replaced with “information about abstinence with age-appropriate sexuality education,” according to section 30 of the bill.

Section 32 reads: “Although African American adolescents, ages 13 through 19, represent only 15% of the adolescent population in the United States, they accounted for 73% of new AIDS cases reported among adolescents in 2004.”

Grant “recipients include...not-for-profit coalitions working to prevent teenage pregnancy, schools, entities that provide after-school programs,” etc.

Applicants given highest funding priority are those targeting populations or communities in which teenage pregnancy or birth rates are increasing or are higher than the corresponding State average.

**Millions of taxpayer dollars will be funneled to the abortion industry, a business that already receives over \$286 million each year from federal taxpayers.**

As the nation’s largest abortion business, Planned Parenthood, already targeting minority and African-American communities, is the likely recipient of the bulk of the funding.
