

**A Most Infamous Anniversary - January 22**

January 22, 1973 – 36 years ago, the pre-born baby was declared a “non-person” in our United States. It is estimated that, at least, 50 million pre-born babies have died from barbaric abortion procedures, with an average of 3800 babies killed daily. However, due to the lack of reporting requirements regarding abortions, we have no exact numbers.

Available statistics tell us that these babies are aborted for many reasons ... they are not physically or mentally perfect; they are the wrong sex or the wrong race; their mothers are “too young” or “too old;” but, most of all, they are inconvenient and cannot be allowed to live. We are killing ourselves...

**January 18** will be observed as **Sanctity of Human Life Sunday** in churches across the nation.

The **National March for Life** will take place on **January 22** at the Mall in Washington, D.C.

Rock for Life’s **Pro-life Youth Training** is **January 21-23**, on Capitol Hill, with prayer at Planned Parenthood, the White House, and the U.S. Supreme Court. The theme is: **“Personhood Now.”**

**“Change” is Coming !!**

On the website of President-elect Barack Obama is a 55-page document, “Advancing Reproductive Rights and Health in a New Administration.”

The pro-abortion document signers want more money – nearly \$3 billion – from the government.

- Four of the many recommendations are:
- **Provide \$1 Billion** for International Family Planning programs
  - **Restore funding** to the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA)
  - **Increase funding** for the Title X Family Planning Program to \$700 million
  - **Remove** funding from Abstinence-Only Programs

Altogether, the proposed policies will accomplish the following:

- 1) treat abortion as a health care right
- 2) provide funding for abortions by insurance carriers or the government
- 3) install judges and political appointees who will protect abortion and government funding from future challenges.

Should the new administration follow the steps for “Advancing Reproductive Rights...”we can expect renewed government funding of abortion

and removal of:

The Mexico City policy, Hyde Amendment, Kemp-Kasten Amendment, and the Weldon Amendment.

Restriction on emergency contraception (Plan B) will be stopped. All abstinence-only programs will be ended.

The recent HHS regulation protecting pro-life physicians and institutions will be reversed.

The document rarely uses the word, “abortion.” Instead, phrases like the *“health care needs of women;”* and *“reproductive health services”* are prevalent.

Previous policies and legislation restricting abortion and its funding are referred to as the product of “ideology” or a “political agenda.” “Dialogue” or “lowering” the number of abortions is not mentioned.

We must not give up. Plan, now, to lobby our Congressman, Doug Lamborn, and our U.S. Senators, Mark Udall and Ken Salazar (or his replacement) **often** via phone, letter and e-mail.

4. It is quite conclusive now, that the more sex education, the more sexual activity and all the problems that go with that. The introduction of sex education is well correlated with the **increase** in abortion, STDs and boy-girl interpersonal problems...
5. The earlier the sex education, the younger the children who explore sex and try various sexual techniques. Present evidence makes it possible to also conclude that the earlier the sex education, the earlier the sexual behavior. Thus sexual education is sexual titillation.
6. In preventing disease and pregnancy, sex education has been a failure. Sex education has had the opposite effect in preventing young people from engaging in “risky sexual behavior.”
7. The idea of “safe sex” has failed. Frightening children with the dangers of “unprotected sex”, drugs, fast driving, alcohol, etc. has, for many children, the paradoxical effect of increasing their interest in trying it. (To be continued)

## *Race & Sex-based Equality*

Called a new front in the abortion wars, the Prenatal Nondiscrimination Act, H.R. 7016, was introduced into Congress in September, '08 by Trent Franks, (R) AZ2.

The Act co-sponsored by Democrats, Lipinski, IL3 and Taylor, MS4 along with Republicans, Pense, IN6 and Fortenberry, NE1 will “prohibit discrimination against the unborn on the basis of sex or race.”

Who would question that the worst form of discrimination is to deny unborn women or Blacks the right to life precisely on account of their innate characteristics of race or gender?

Sex-selective abortion is practiced in the U.S. by immigrant populations who bring with them their prejudices against girls and preference for sons.

The ready availability of both ultrasounds and abortions makes it easy for them to act on these prejudices.

Regarding race-based abortions, Planned Parenthood has located four out of five of its abortuaries in minority low-income neighborhoods with Blacks as the primary target.

One-third of all U. S. abortions are performed on Blacks. They are only 13 percent of the population.

PP has widely distributed its literature in Spanish to conservative Hispanic communities. Spanish-speaking “outreach directors” have been hired to bring in Latinas.

Because of PP’s relentless efforts, the Alaska Natives (historically called Eskimos) have one of the highest abortion rates in America.

The abortion lobby is working to ‘allow’ Native Americans the “right” to tax-funded abortions, currently dis-allowed by the Hyde Amendment.

Working for passage of the Prenatal Nondiscrimination Act (PreNDA) should stimulate public debate on grounds favorable to the prolife cause.

Certainly it is an “incremental” approach, but it should be supportable as long as it doesn’t say that all other abortions are acceptable.

## *“Early Induction” - Eugenics*

In an “early induction” abortion, medical staff induces labor after a pre-natal diagnosis determines that a baby is severely disabled.

Labor is induced at a point so early in pregnancy (21 weeks) that it would be impossible even for a healthy child to live outside the womb without highly specialized intensive care.

Under these circumstances a child with a severe disability, lacking that intensive care, is unlikely to survive more than a few minutes.

Recently, the issue of “early induction” was again raised when a Catholic Hospital in London, Ontario, was found to have been using the procedure for the past twenty years.

Several years ago, it was learned that one of the Colorado Springs hospitals was doing that procedure – and may or may not still be using it.

From the moral perspective, who has the right to say that another’s life is not worth living as long as that person is able?

### **BUSH ENACTS CONSCIENCE PROTECTION FOR PROLIFE HEALTH**

The right of federally funded health care providers to decline to participate in services to which they object, such as abortion, is affirmed by a final regulation that has been issued by the U.S. Dept. of Health & Human Services (HHS).

The timing of the issuance places it to take effect on January 20<sup>th</sup> – the same day pro-abortion President-elect Obama will be inaugurated.

“Doctors and other health care providers should not be forced to choose between good professional standing and violating their conscience,” HHS Secretary Mike Leavitt said.

“This rule protects the right of medical providers to care for their patients in accord with their conscience.”
